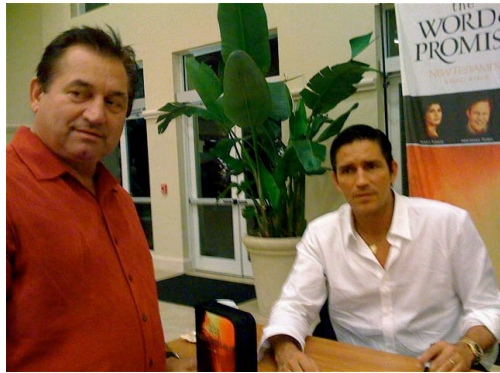

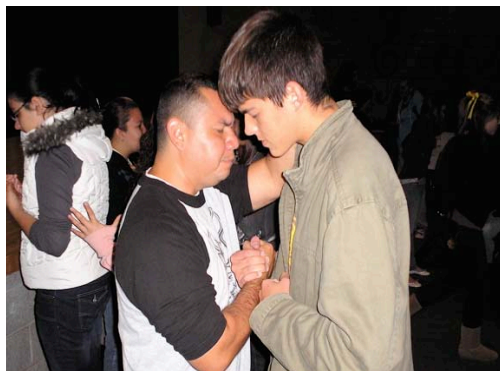
Dear ZM Friends:
