These student leaders are very transparent as they share how God has changed their lives.

Steps to forming a Legacy Club include:

- 1) Securing a teacher sponsor
- 2) Proposing the club to school administrators
- 3) Identifying student leaders
- 4) Delivering our constitution and then setting dates for our meetings. Prayer surrounds the entire process

One of the blessings of serving these young student leaders is to engage them in conversation about their lives, needs and goals. I asked this question, "What are you getting out of Legacy Club meetings?"
