The new school year began at the end of August. It is a critical time for our ministry to begin its work. Each school has a student-parent orientation. Our leadership teams set up tables and displays to attract the people to hear about our mission and sign up. At Wiregrass Ranch HS well over 100 students signed up in the few hours the table was open. The same is true of the other schools. Our leaders share with the parents about the benefits of having their students as part of our club. It is Recruitment 101 at its best.

Our plans are to grow the ministry to new schools and to train their leaders. We also have a full load of HS football chapels every week. Our needs are, finances to continue the work, prayer from our friends and supporters, and volunteers to help out at these various schools and minister to the members.



Our first year at Freedom HS brought out some of our leaders to the parent-student orientation. We are also doing their football chapel that will help the club grow.



Team members of the Bloomingdale HS football team attend their first FB chapel. Our ministry is coordinating 5 chapels weekly with more to come. For many of these players this is the closest they come to a church service. We are joining with church youth pastors to accomplish this work.



Students and teachers gathered at Gaither HS for their "Annual Jericho Walk." They met before the opening of school to pray for their students, teachers, administrators and workers. This is the 25th year for this event. Prayer really works!

HOW TO OBTAIN THE BLESSINGS OF GOD— A DEVOTION FOR OUR STUDENTS.

First, you need to know for sure you are a child of God, born again, trusting in Jesus Christ alone for forgiveness of your sins who was crucified, buried and raised on the third day. Don't procrastinate! Today is the day of salvation.

What is a blessing anyway? Webster's 1828 Dictionary: Making happy; wishing happiness to; praising or extolling; consecrating by prayer

We then see that blessings from God are important in life if we are to be truly happy and spiritually prosperous.

Five Principles for a Young Person to be Blessed by God.

First: We must have the proper attitude towards our parents or guardians.

Regardless of your home situation, they deserve your love, respect, and honor. You must obey them unless they ask you to do something against the Word of God.

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother (which is the first commandment with a promise), so it may be well with you and that you may live long on earth." Ephesians 6: 1-3

Second: We must choose to live a life that is obedient to God's Word. This does not mean you are perfect but you strive to follow His directions, and when you fail, you confess it. 1 John 1:9. God blesses obedience, He does not bless disobedience and He never will.

"I am setting before you today a blessing and a curse: the blessing, if you listen to the commandments of the LORD your God, which I am commanding you today; and the curse, if you do not listen to the commandments of the LORD your God." Deut. 11:26-28

Third: We must spend quality time in prayer.

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you." Matt. 7:7-11

Fourth: We must have faith in God. No matter what you face in this life, remember God has all power in His hands and He is able to work it out. Trust Him!

"So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ." Rom. 10:17

Fifth: We must get in the habit of giving.
"Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return." Luke 6:38

"I will lift up my eyes to the mountains; from where shall my help come? My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth." Psalm 121:1-2
