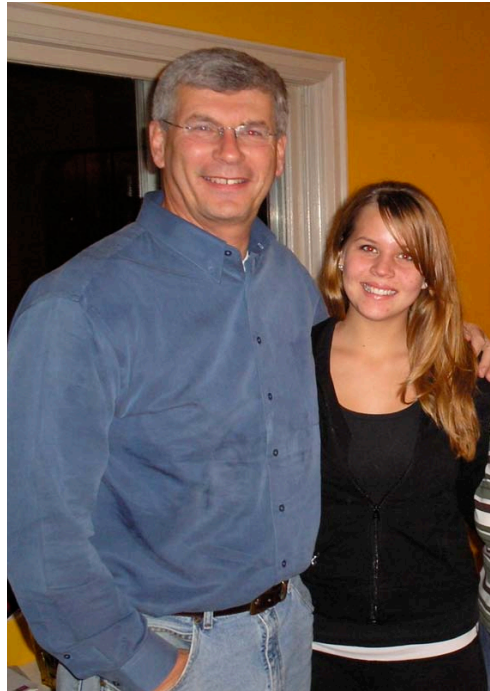
Gaither HS sponsor Cindy Smith, holds Leadership Training at her home to kick-start the upcoming school year.
